ICMC Weekend Islamic School Student Code of Conduct & Rules

- 1. Always say Salaam Alaikum when coming to the school and entering classroom
- 2. Be respectful to your teacher and other students,
- 3. Listen to your teacher, and behave good in the classroom & school.
- 4. Keep your hands and feet to yourself.
- 5. All phones and smart technology must be put away at the start of each class.
- 6. Leave the classroom only if you have Teacher permission.
- 7. Need to do at home your weekly classwork reviews and any assigned homework.
- 8. Always keep wearing your shoes in school except when going to mussallah.
- 9. Do not go or use bathrooms without shoes at anytime.
- 10. No use of phones or mobile watches except if receiving Emergency call.
- 11. No use of cell phones or other personal digital devices unless when approved by school.
- 12. No harassing verbally, physically, hitting, or cyber bullying, etc. of fellow students, teachers or others.
- 13. No indecent language and images to be spoken, drawn or written.
- 14. No damaging the property of ICMC or others.
- 15. No bringing of harmful items.
- 16. No eating in classrooms, and No chewing gum in school.
- 17. **Dress Code:** No jewelry on boys. No shorts. No hats or baseball caps. No dresses with images of people and animals. Boys and girls dress appropriately in the spirit of modesty and humility to Allah (swt). Also head scarves are required to be worn by girls.

SERIOUS SCHOOL RULES VIOLATIONS:

Below are the serious rules violations that can result in reporting to parents, suspension and expulsion from the school.

- 1. Disrespectful: Engaging in disrespectful talking or other actions on School staff, students, or others at school.
- 2. Abuse: Engaging in physical or cyber bullying, name calling, pushing, hitting, or touching others, or other physical or verbal abuse.
- 3. Indecency: Indecent language and images to be spoken, drawn or written.
- 4. Damage: Breaking, damaging or defacing school property or other's personal property.
- 5. Stealing & Lying: Taking of school or other persons property without their permission.
- 6. Endangerment: Bringing to school any form of harmful devices, such as guns, explosives, chemicals, knives, etc. that can pose physical or other risks at the school.

Any violation of these or other rules of ICMC will warrant a warning and if necessary suspension or expulsion at the decision of the school Principal and Administration.

- a. First offense, verbal warning.
- b. Second offense, in-school suspension, with notification of parents.
- c. Third offense, out-of-school suspension.
- d. Fourth offense, expulsion, no refund of money.
